 Embankment repairing -Saran (one village has been take by MP under Model village yojna)

MITIGATION

- Repairing of embankment during flood season. (sand bag, bolder pitching)
- Repairing of cannel with PCC
- Di-siltation of cannel for better drainage.
- Deployment of a person for the inspection during flood time by Water resources departmrnt.

RISK REDUCTION

- Training of Task force members by NDRF- in 2013
- Training of Departmental staff on Disaster preparedness
- Participation of government staffs in Mock drill.
- Awareness on Flood safety week.
